




POCKET AM/FM RADIO

LOCATION OF CONTROLS

- 1. FM Telescopic Antenna
- 2. Earbud Jack
- 3. AM/FM Band Selector
- 4. Tuning Control
- 5. Power ON/OFF & Volume Control
- 6. Speaker
- 7. Belt Clip
- 8. Battery Compartment Door
- 9. Belt Clip Tab





POWER SOURCE

This Pocket AM/FM Radio operates on 2 'AA' (UM-3) batteries (Not included).

BATTERY INSTALLATION

- 1. Remove the BATTERY DOOR (#8).
- 2. Following the polarity diagram (+ and -) shown in the battery compartment, and insert 2 'AA' (UM-3) batteries (not included).
- 3. Replace the BATTERY DOOR (#8).

IMPORTANT: Be sure that the batteries are installed correctly. Wrong polarity may damage the unit.

Note:

- For best performance and longer operating time, we recommend the use of alkaline-type batteries.
- ii. Do not mix old and new batteries.
- iii. Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable (nickel-cadmium) batteries.
- iv. If the unit is not going to be used for an extended period of time, remove the

- batteries. Old or leaking batteries can cause damage to the unit and may void the warranty.
- v. Do not dispose of batteries in fire, batteries may explode or leak.

RADIO OPERATION

- 1. Turn the Volume Control (#5) in a clockwise direction to turn ON the unit. A "Click" will be heard, and the speaker (#6) will become active.
- Set the Band Selector (#3) to "AM" or "FM" depending on which band you want to listen to.
- 3. Rotate the Tuning Control (#4) to select a desired radio station.
- 4. Adjust the Volume Control (#5) to obtain the desired sound level.
- To turn the Radio OFF, rotate the Volume Knob (#5) in a counter-clockwise until hear a 'Click" sound is heard and the speaker (#6) turns off.

TIPS FOR BEST RECEPTION

- i. When listening to an FM station, fully extend the FM telescopic antenna.
- ii. When listening to AM station, be sure to place the unit in a vertical position and rotate or reposition the unit until the best AM reception.

USING EARBUDS (not included)

- 1. Plug your earbuds into the jack (#2) on the side of the unit. The unit speaker is disabled when earbuds are plugged in.
- 2. Follow the Radio Operation steps above for listening to the radio.

READ THIS IMPORTANT INFORMATION BEFORE USING YOUR EARBUDS

- 1. Avoid extended play at very high volume as it may impair your hearing.
- 2. If you experience ringing in your ears, reduce the volume or shut off your unit.
- 3. Do not use while driving a motorized vehicle. This is dangerous and also illegal in some states.
- 4. Keep the volume at a reasonable level even if your headset is an open-air type designed to allow you to hear outside sounds. Please note that excessively high volume may still block outside sounds.

DETACHING THE BELT CLIP

- Gently pull up on the Belt Clip Tab (#9) to unlock the belt clip.
- 2. Carefully remove the Belt Clip (#7) by sliding it downward to remove it from its slot.

Note: Do not pull up on the belt clip or apply excessive force when trying to remove it. This could break the belt clip, and void the warranty.

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

- 1. Never wrap the earbuds cord around any animal or person. Special care should be taken with long wires.
- Clean your unit with a damp (never wet) cloth. Solvent or detergent should never be used.
- 3. Do not expose the unit to rain, moisture or extreme temperature.
- 4. Avoid leaving your unit in direct sunlight or in hot, humid or dusty places.
- Keep your unit away from heating appliances and sources of electrical noise such as fluorescent lamps or motors.

90 DAY LIMITED WARRANTY AND SERVICE VALID IN THE U.S.A. ONLY

This warranty is not assignable or transferable. Our obligation under this warranty is the repair or replacement of the defective unit or any part thereof, except batteries, when it is returned to the SPECTRA Service Department, accompanied by proof of the date of original consumer purchase, such as a duplicate copy of a sales receipt.

You must pay all shipping charges required to ship the product to SPECTRA for warranty service. If the product is repaired or replaced under warranty, the return charges will be at SPECTRA's expense. There are no other express warranties other than those stated herein.

This warranty is valid only in accordance with the conditions set forth below:

- 1. The warranty applies to the SPECTRA product only while:
 - a. It remains in the possession of the original purchaser and proof of purchase is demonstrated.
 - b. It has not been subjected to accident, misuse, abuse, improper service, usage outside the descriptions and warnings covered within the user manual or non-SPECTRA approved modifications.
 - c. Claims are made within the warranty period.
- 2. This warranty does not cover damage or equipment failure caused by electrical wiring not in compliance with electrical codes or SPECTRA user manual specifications, or failure to provide reasonable care and necessary maintenance as outlined in the user manual.
- 3. Warranty of all SPECTRA products applies to residential use only and is void when products are used in a nonresidential environment or installed outside the United States.

This warranty gives you specific legal rights, and you may also have other rights which vary from state to state. TO OBTAIN SERVICE please remove all batteries (if any) and pack the unit carefully and send it freight prepaid to SPECTRA at the address shown below. IF THE UNIT IS RETURNED WITHIN THE WARRANTY PERIOD shown above, please include a proof of purchase (dated cash register receipt) so that we may establish your eligibility for warranty service and repair of the unit without cost. Also include a note with a description explaining how the unit is defective. A customer service representative may need to contact you regarding the status of your repair, so please include your name, address, phone number and email address to expedite the process.

IF THE UNIT IS OUTSIDE THE WARRANTY PERIOD, please include a check for \$5.00 to cover the cost of repair, handling and return postage. All out of warranty returns must be sent prepaid.
