

This system is equipped with non-skid rubber 'feet' to prevent the product from moving when you operate the controls. These 'feet' are made from non-migrating rubber material specially formulated to avoid leaving any marks or stains on your furniture. However certain types of oil based furniture polishes, wood preservatives, or cleaning sprays may cause the rubber 'feet' to soften, and leave marks or a rubber residue on the furniture.

To prevent any damage to your furniture we strongly recommend that you purchase small self-adhesive felt pads, available at hardware stores and home improvement centers everywhere, and apply these pads to the bottom of the rubber 'feet' before you place the product on fine wooden furniture.

## POWER SUPPLY

Before connecting to the power supply ensure that the supply corresponds to the rating information on the back of the apparatus: 120V ~60Hz DC Power: 9V battery type 6LR61(not provided) for clock back-up system only. An alkaline type battery is ecommended. For optimum performance, this Battery should be replaced every 6 months. Insert the AC power cord (14) into a convenient standard AC wall outlet.
 Connect the 9V battery inside the compartment at the bottom of the unit (13).

BACK-UP SYSTEM: Ensure that the unit will continue to operate as normal during an AC power disruption (in order to preserve the battery life the display will not light). All clock setting will be kept in the memory, however, the clock time may require adjustment for exact accuracy. If this battery is not installed, the display will blink "12:00" to indicate that you have to redo the time and alarm setting.

Disconnect the mains plug from the supply socket when not in use. To avoid the risk of electric shock do not remove the cover of the apparatus. There are no user serviceable parts inside. To prevent fire or shock hazard do not expose the apparatus to rain or moisture.

1. Set the ON/OFF/AUTO Switch (11) to "OFF". Connect the Main Cord to the power supply. The clock display will blink "12:00" to indicate that you have to set your desired time. 2. Press and hold Time Set Button (7) and press Minute Set Button (3), or Hour Set Button (2) to adjust to your

- 3. Release Time Set button (7) to store your setting in memory.
- LISTENING TO THE RADIO I. Set the ON/OFF/AUTO Switch (11) to "ON" position.
- 2. Set to FM or AM position with the Band Switch (1) . 3. For a better reception in FM, extend the wire antenna (15). In AM, rotate the unit.

- SETTING THE ALARM AND WAKE-UP MODE
- 1. Press and hold the Alarm Set Button (4) and Minutes Set Button (3), or Hour Set Button (2) to adjust your desired alarm time, then release the ALARM Set Button (4) to store your setting in memory. 2. To wake up radio, follow 1 to 5 in "LISTENING TO THE RADIO", then select to the AUTO position (11), the Auto
- indicator (3) will alight. 3. To wake-up to alarm sound, Switch the ON/OFF/AUTO Switch (11) to AUTO position. Turn the volume control -**OFF** (2) fully anti-clockwise to select the BUZZ position, the AUTO indicator(3) will alight. 4. The alarm can be temporarily stopped for 9 minutes by pressing the Snooze off Button (9).
- 5. The alarm will activate again after 24 hours unless the ON/OFF/AUTO Switch (11) is set to "OFF". Note: When setting the time or alarm time, observe the PM indicator (16) to ensure you have set to the correct 12 hour period. When setting alarm time always remember to release the Minute Set or Hour Set Button before releasing the Alarm Set/Off Button to ensure that the real time will not be affected.
- 1. Set your favorite radio station, slide the ON/OFF/AUTO Switch (11) to "OFF" or "AUTO".
- Press the Sleep Set Button (6) and the display 59 minutes as default timer period. The setting my be decreased by pressing Minute Set Button (3) while holding down "Sleep set (6) simultaneously. 3. The sleep timer may also be set up to 1 hour 59 minutes by pressing "Hour set (2) once while holding down

"Sleep set (6) simultaneously.

4. The radio will play for the set period and turn itself off automatically off. 5. To turn off the radio prior to the end of sleep timer setting simply press "SNOOZE off " (9) once.
